# PANDE-MONIUM: SCENES FROM QUARANTINE 

A one-minute play in tableaus by Jake Lewis

Setting: A living room with two parents and two young children. (Music is encouraged to play in the background. Depending upon your interpretation, it can be silly -- a la "The Bennie Hill Show" or melodramatic/serious, like some new age piece. Or it can change per tableau! I heard the theme song to the film "K-PAX" in my head as I wrote this.)

A person on the side of the stage holds up a card that says "QUARANTINE - DAY 1."

FAMILY is in a frozen tableau shrugging, as if they're saying, "No big deal." Lights fade.

A person on the side of the stage holds up a card that says "QUARANTINE - DAY 2."

FAMILY now is shown, all smiles, heading towards the front door to go on a hike. Lights fade.
A person on the side of the stage holds up a card that says "QUARANTINE - DAY 3."
FAMILY is shown in a frozen tableau doing crafts, reading. Lights fade.
A person on the side of the stage holds up a card that says "QUARANTINE - DAY 4." FAMILY is shown in a frozen tableau, all sleeping. Lights fade.

A person on the side of the stage holds up a card that says "QUARANTINE - DAY 5."
FAMILY is shown playing video games, watching TV, looking at phones. Lights fade.
A person on the side of the stage holds up a card that says "QUARANTINE - DAY 6."

CHILDREN are shown in a frozen tableau, screaming, making a mess. PARENTS look like they're restraining their temper. Lights fade.

A person on the side of the stage holds up a card that says "QUARANTINE - DAY 7."

PARENTS are in a frozen tableau, holding an empty toilet paper roll. Lights fade.
A person on the side of the stage holds up a card that says "QUARANTINE - DAY 8."

FAMILY is in a frozen tableau, all mad at each other, crying. Lights fade.

A person on the side of the stage holds up a card that says "QUARANTINE - DAY 9."
FAMILY is gathered together on the couch, or looking out a window, embracing each other. Lights hold for a longer period of time, then fade to black.
